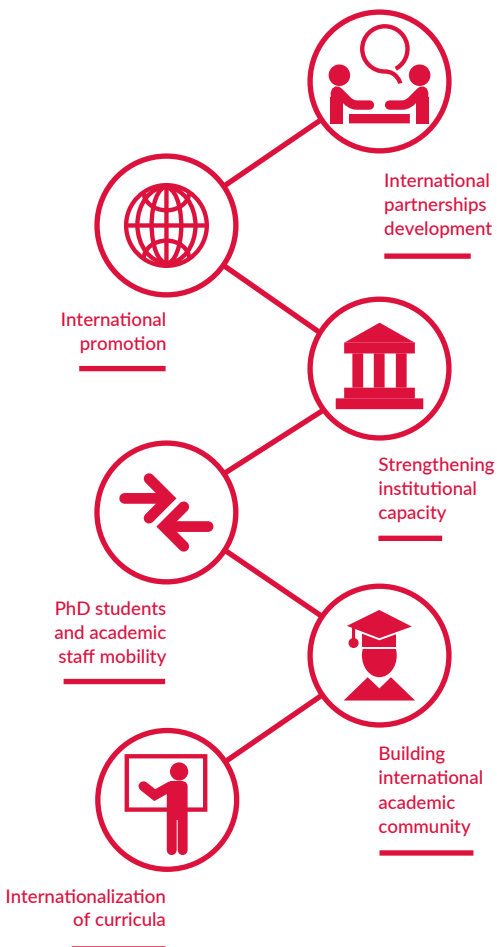


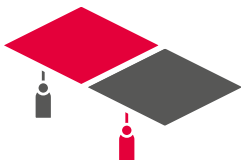

KATAMARAN

IMPLEMENTATION OF JOINT SECOND-CYCLE STUDIES



Why the Katamaran Programme?

The Programme aims to support Polish higher education institutions (HEIs) in the implementation of international curricula during joint second-cycle studies leading to a joint diploma and to increase mobility of students and academic staff.

Who is entitled to submit an application?

Polish public and private HEIs holding an Erasmus Charter for Higher Education.

What is the Programme's schedule?

Duration of the call II for applications:

13 February 2020 – 29 May 2020

Projects implementation period:

1 October 2020 – 30 June 2023

Duration of the call III for applications:

September 2020 – November 2020

Projects implementation period:

April 2021 – September 2023

What activities are covered by the Programme?

- activities aiming at opening enrollment for studies
- activities related to the implementation of international joint second-cycle studies, including:
 - paying out scholarships to students of Polish HEIs travelling abroad and to students of a foreign HEI visiting Poland under the implemented studies curriculum
 - organising or participating in lectures, study visits or working meetings of teaching and scientific staff together with a foreign Partner
 - organising adaptive, integrative, and inter-cultural training or training related to new methods of education for staff and students

What is the budget for a project?

Budget for a single project – at most PLN 1 000 000

Budget for the Programme (call II) – PLN 20 000 000

Budget for the Programme (call III) – PLN 20 000 000
