SCIENTISTS

POLISH RETURNS

The objective of the Programme is to enable Polish scientists to return to their country and conduct a world-class research in Polish higher education institutions or research units.

THE BEKKER PROGRAMME – MID- AND LONG-TERM OUTGOING MOBILITY OF SCIENTISTS

The Programme aims to increase the international mobility of scientists and academic professors employed at Polish universities and scientific units by enabling them to conduct research or teach in renowned foreign centres around the world.

THE WALCZAK PROGRAMME – OUTGOING MOBILITY OF RESEARCHERS-SPECIALISTS IN MEDICAL SCIENCE

The Programme is created to strengthen the potential of Polish scientific units and medical entities by supporting the international mobility of researchers in the field of cardiology, oncology, allergology and infectious diseases.

THE IWANOWSKA PROGRAMME – MID-TERM OUTGOING MOBILITY OF PHD STUDENTS

The NAWA Scholarship Programme supports the international mobility of outgoing PhD students and gives them an opportunity to gain experience at prestigious universities and research institutions around the world.

THE ULAM PROGRAMME – MID- AND LONG-TERM MOBILITY OF INCOMING SCIENTISTS

Objective of the Programme is to increase internationalisation of academic and scientific staff of Polish HEIs, and research institutes. The Programme enables visits of scientists for 6-24 month research.

THE CYBULSKI PROGRAMME – LONG-TERM MOBILITY OF INCOMING SCIENTISTS

The Programme aims to increase the number of international of scientists doing research and teaching in the Polish scientific institutions/entities.

THE ZNANIECKI PROGRAMME – MID-TERM MOBILITY OF INCOMING PHD STUDENTS

The scholarship provides foreign PhD students with an opportunity to conduct part of their research at Polish universities. The Programme enables also participation in full PhD pathway.

BILATERAL EXCHANGE OF SCIENTISTS

The purpose of bilateral exchange of scientists is to support the mobility of researchers between the participating countries to carry out joint research projects.

Scholarships for the Polish diaspora are addressed to foreigners of Polish origin and enable young people to study in Poland.

THE BANACH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

The aim of the Programme is to support the social and economic growth of Central-Asian, Eastern Partnership and Western Balkan countries by offering grants for Master degree studies in Poland.

THE LUKASIEWICZ SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

The scholarship offers free education as part of a Masters in the following areas of study: physical sciences, natural sciences, technical sciences, agricultural, forestry and veterinary sciences for nationals of developing countries.

CERTIFICATION OFFICE OF POLISH LANGUAGE

The first state certificate examinations in Polish as a foreign language were administered in Poland and internationally in 2004. Since that time almost 300 of examination sessions were organized and nearly 12 000 candidates took the exam on B1, B2, C1 and C2 levels.
