

#### INTRODUCTION

This study contains statistical data for the academic year 2021–2022 showing the number of foreign students and staff (academic teachers) at Polish HEIs.

The source of data is the <u>Integrated System of Information on Science and Higher Education</u> – *POLon*:

- 1. the data about **students** refers to **86,164 foreign nationals** reported by the universities for the winter semester of the academic year 2021/2022,
  - the tables show universities with at least 200 students from abroad and countries with at least 500 citizens studying in Poland,
  - the "country of origin" was indicated on the basis of the "country of birth" and, in the absence of such information, on the basis of the "country of issue of identity document",
- 2. the data about **academic teachers** refers to **2,544 foreign nationals** with a stated active employment and active terms of employment and with a filed declaration of disciplines valid as of 31 December 2021. additional comments and clarifications:
  - as for the group of foreign academic teachers employed at Polish HEIs, the tables in the report are limited to the institutions employing at least 20 foreign teachers (the same was done for countries of origin),
  - the teachers were counted according to the scientific domains corresponding to the declared disciplines – those who did not have a declaration of the disciplines they represent were marked in the tables with the remark "no delcaration",
  - due to the fact that staff members may appear simultaneously in two disciplines (this concerns approximately 65 staff members in the collection analysed), one staff member may have been counted more than once,
  - the "country of origin" was indicated on the basis of the "country of birth" and, in the absence of such information, on the basis of the "country of issue of identity document",
  - Information on the academic degree/title held has been standardised and presented in groups: prof. (professor), dr. hab. (post-doctoral degree), dr (doctor), others.

The above limitations in fully showing the size of individual groups (especially academic teachers) are necessary to ensure their anonymity.

The data presented were downloaded from the **POLon system in July 2022 according to the status of the database as of 31 December 2021**.

The study is intentionally not provided with analytical commentary as it meant to serve illustrative purposes.

### 3 CONCLUSIONS

General conclusions from the collected data:

- **3.1.** The group of foreign students in Poland is more than 30 times larger than the group of foreign academic teachers.
- **3.2.** People from Ukraine predominate among both students and academic teachers.
- **3.3.** In terms of countries of origin, the group of academic teachers is definitely more geographically diverse.
- **3.4.** The universities hosting the largest number of foreign students and academic teachers are diverse. The largest public universities appear in both groups, but in the case of students, non-public universities lead the way.
- **3.5.** Foreigners representing exact and natural sciences are predominant among academic teachers. Foreign students, on the other hand, most frequently choose management as their field of study.
