The University of Tartu in Figures




- Founded in 1632, oldest and the only comprehensive university in Estonia
- ~14 200 students (~ 13% international), incl. ~ 1100 PhD students
- ~ 3400 employees (~ 1800 academic staff members; 13,5% international)
- Ranked in the top 1% (top 300) of world universities
- Four faculties, 31 institutes, including four regional colleges




Participation in Horizon Europe

- Until recently we didn't prioritize MSCA
- General low success rate in MSCA
- We're not very well known and can't change geographical location



Challenges with MSCA-PF

Horizon Europe

- 2 postdoctoral fellowships
- 3 doctoral networks
- 1 staff exchange



Solutions

Systematic approach has been successful in ERC. Using similar approach in MSCA-PF:

- Early start
- Can't have too much communication
- Seal of Excellence
- Support for supervisors
