


# Global student mobility continues to be on the rise

- to the benefit of countries like Germany and Poland



#### **International student mobility**





- In 2021, around **6.4 million students** were enrolled outside their home country, according to UNESCO.
- Since 2011, the number of internationally mobile students has increased by around 2.4 million or 59%.

- The US is the key host country, Germany recently ranked third
- Key country of origin is China

- International students account for 12.6% of all students in Germany



#### **Regions and countries of origin**




- Asia and Pacific are key regions of origin for international students with a share of 32%
- India is the key country of origion for the first time, with 12% of all international students in Germany


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## German (European) students are slightly less mobile than before

 our more diverse student bodies are not consistently reached by traditional mobility programs and formats




#### German students abroad 1991-2022




- Digitalization offers **opportunities** as well as limits for participation in international exchange


